WHO WE SERVE

These facilities are spread throughout the Chicagoland area and provide services to over 4,000 children, adults with disabilities, and their families. El Valor's 300+ staff members all come from the community and have a passion for providing inclusive services to the most vulnerable in a safe and intercultural competent environment.

RESPITE SERVICES

El Valor's Respite Services provide short-term relief and assistance to families, parents, and caregivers of children and adults with developmental disabilities.

Our Respite Program is designed for primary parents and caregivers who have the sole responsibility of providing around the clock care to a loved one with a disability. Trained and experienced respite program workers provide a rest period for caregivers. The sole purpose is for the caregivers to take a break, rest, and renew their energy. This time could be utilized for running errands, personal medical appointments, or simply to provide a restful break for self-care.
